

IMPORTANT NOTICE

VEHICLE REGISTRATION & PARKING PASSES

All vehicles parked in a Resident Parking, including both reserved and un-reserved parking spaces, must display the new ParcReston Association parking permit. Vehicles must be registered with Management before parking to avoid being towed.

If you already have a sticker, please make sure your information, including vehicle registration, is up to date, on OnCallParking (including vehicle registration) and stop by the office to get your new passes

If you do not have a sticker, please follow the link below to enter your information and register your vehicle(s), before going to the management office.

QUICK START GUIDE

Make sure that you have your registration keyword, a copy of your driver's license, proof of insurance and vehicle registration for all vehicles in your application.

RESIDENT STICKERS (RESERVED AND UNRESERVED SPACES)

- Each unit will receive a maximum of two (2) vehicle decals with proof of DMV vehicle registration at ParcReston. You must provide your vehicle registration in order to receive your new parking passes. Cars that have not been registered with the DMV, will be given a 60-day temporary pass until the vehicle has been registered with the DMV.
- Units with two (2) vehicles registered, will also be issued a hangtag that is to be used when parking in an **UNRESERVED** parking space. All vehicles parked in unreserved spaces must display **both** the ParcReston vehicle decal and the hang tag, to avoid having the vehicle towed.



We have a limited amount of parking in the ParcReston community. This system will ensure that residents use their reserved spot at all times and leave ample unreserved parking for residents with two vehicles.

The goal of the parking policy is to ensure sure that each resident has peace of mind that they can come home and park easily and safely without concern for unauthorized vehicles in the community. Using an electronic permit system, the property is regularly monitored to make certain that only vehicles belonging to you and your neighbors (and any authorized guest vehicles, of course) are parked at **ParcReston**. There have been no changes to the parking policy. What has changed is the method to register your vehicle and the way you now register a guest.

WHAT ABOUT GUESTS?

If you have a guest visiting, we've made it as simple as possible for you to register their vehicle in our system so that they can enjoy the same hassle-free parking benefits you do.

**All vehicles not displaying the Parc Reston Condominium stickers and hang-tags
After April 1st 2020 are subject to towing**

1. All vehicles parked at Parc Reston must display a current PRC parking pass. Excluding motorcycles and vehicles in a carport.
2. All visitors must be parked in visitor parking. **All guest vehicles must be registered in oncallparking.com at any time of the day.** Guest do not need to display anything while parking in a guest space, they just need to be registered. Each unit will be allowed to register 2 visitors every night. Guest must park in spaces designated as "Guest parking". No vehicle may be parked in any of the spaces designated as Guest parking longer that 3 consecutive nights.
3. Residents may only park in parking reserved for residents and visitors may only park in parking reserved for visitors.
4. Each unit will receive a maximum of two (2) vehicle parking passes. One (1) pass for their reserved space and one (1) pass and hangtag for unreserved spaces. Passes will be numbered for control. Passes may not be moved from one vehicle to another.
5. Owners/Tenants registering a vehicle to obtain a parking pass must provide management with a current driver's license, a valid registration and (tenants) **current lease**. These items must reflect your PRC address.
6. PRC management will provide a temporary pass up to 60 days to register your vehicle to your new address or change your existing vehicle to your address.
7. All vehicles must display at all times current state and local registration, license plates, permits and stickers to legally operate on public streets.

PARKING SPACES USAGE

RESERVED SPACES: All spaces that are marked with an "R" after the space number. These spaces can only be used by the assigned unit at all times. Vehicles parked in these spaces must displayed **a valid sticker**, between 6:00pm and 9:00am.

STICKER MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE BACK-WINDSHIELD TOP LEFT CORNER

Please remind your guest or contractors not to use other reserved spots at any time to avoid towing

UN-RESERVED SPACES: All numbered spaces without an "R" after the space number. These spaces are first come first served at all times. Vehicles parked in these spaces must displayed a **valid sticker and a hangtag** between 6:00pm and 9:00am.

STICKER MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE BACK-WINDSHIELD TOP LEFT CORNER

HANG-TAG MUST BE DISPLAYED ON THE REAR-VIEW MIRROR
